### Anthony Gormley's 'Another Place' art exhibition

Crosby Beach has more than a few surprises up its sleeve – 100 in fact. That's the number of cast-iron, life-size figures you'll find here, stretching three kilometres along the shore, and almost one kilometre out to sea. They are the creation of 'Angel of the North' artist Anthony Gormley. placed here as part of a permanent art exhibition entitled 'Another Place'.

These thought-provoking sculptures can only be viewed when the tide is out, so check out the tidal times before you go. Then grab a cuppa, sit back and enjoy the spectacle as they miraculously appear from the sea.

Aside from the art installation there are plenty of other reasons to visit Crosby Beach. There's also a play area, refreshment vans, sand dunes and a place for picnicking. Enjoy a relaxing stroll along the coastal paths, take in stunning estuary views and watch the big ships come and go.
